Dear Comrades,

The Office Bearers of our Federation met in Hyderabad on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 under the Presidentship of Com A Koteswara Rao, the President of our Federation and discussed various aspects confronting our organization in general and certain important matters in particular.

We are happy that Com C H Venkatachalam, General Secretary of AIBEA was in Hyderabad city on some trade union work and he participated in our meeting at our request.

1. **10<sup>TH</sup> BIPARTITE WAGE REVISION:** Most of the Office Bearers have expressed their resentment over inordinate delay in the wage revision negotiations which is resulting in avoidable anger amongst the rank and file. Many of them sought clarifications on the hospitalization scheme. Some of the office bearers communicated that our members are very much unhappy on the leadership of UFBU as there is no common presentation of our issues by the constituent units of UFBU which is creating a wholesale confusion in the minds of the employees. All the office bearers with one voice expressed that the

10<sup>th</sup> Bipartite Wage Revision shall be completed at the earliest as we have to prepare our ranks for bitter struggles in the days to come.

Com C H Venkatachalam, General Secretary of AIBEA in his hour long address has clarified many of the doubts expressed by our office bearers and assured that AIBEA will play a decisive and constructive role in clinching the wage revision true to the aspirations of the employees working in the Banking Industry.

In the evening our Federation has arranged the general bank employees meeting in Hyderabad which was attended by more than 700 employees and the one and half hour address of Com C H Venkatachalam was more educative which was appreciated by everyone.

2. **THE DEVASTATING EFFECT OF HUD HUD TOOPHAN:** Every one of us know the destruction of this toophan on the people of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam Districts and the plight and predicament of the people of Visakhapatnam. Even though there is no much loss to the lives of the people, the loss of property which has caused irreparable damage to the people cannot be described in words. Bank employees were also targeted heavily. The houses of the people have been damaged severely. In one word we can say that the livelihood of the people of these three districts has been traumatized and shattered.

After discussing this issue threadbare, it was decided that a request shall be made to all our bank employees working in the states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana to contribute liberally with a minimum of Rs.200/- each to enable us to undertake some social activities for the people of these three districts. It was also decided that all our units shall collect a minimum of Rs.200/- each from all our members and ensure that by 15<sup>th</sup> of December the total remittances are made without any further delay. On our request our national organization AIBEA has also agreed to contribute Rs.12 lacs for this noble cause.



We are confident that all our members will respond positively for our call and we assured them that we undertake a very good activity which will be useful to the people.

3. **ALL INDIA YUVA SAMMELAN:** AIBEA has decided to organize the first All India Yuva Samelan for the benefit of the young recruitees in the banks and we are delighted that an opportunity has been provided to APBEF to organize this historical event. We have already booked RTC Kalyana Mandapam, Baghlingampally and we are going to hold this event on 31<sup>st</sup> of January, 2015 and 1<sup>st</sup> of February, 2015 in Hyderabad. It was decided in the meeting to put all out efforts for the success of this historical event.
